American essayist Susan Sontag wrote that we are all citizens of two countries: the "kingdom of the well" and the "kingdom of the sick." But few of us want to dwell in this second country, even though doing so is most likely inevitable, even if temporary.

Rebecca, along with her colleagues, has developed and teaches a unique, multidisciplinary course on "Suffering and Death," combining theology and nursing/ social work principles and practices for nursing students and social work majors at

the University of Portland. The course is not focused on clinical skill-building but rather on spiritual development and practical learning.

In this first-time ever opportunity for both clergy and anyone else who cares for others on their human journey, Rebecca will be leading attendees in humane, practical, biblical, and spiritual reflections on being present with those we care about—and for—on their journeys through illness and death.

Dr. Gaudino is a published ordained UCC minister and a faculty member of the University of Portland Department of Theology.
